Core Content Courses

All middle school students are required to take 4 core content courses each year: Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Math. Students do not select these courses. The school counselor and middle school administrator place students in the appropriate class based on their grade level and individual student data.

Scheduling Overview

All middle school students will have 6 class periods each day

4 periods will be for full-year core classes (listed above)

2 periods will be for electives, which can be scheduled in different ways:

- 4 semester-long electives
- 1 full-year elective + 2 semester-long electives
- 2 full-year electives

Important Acknowledgments

Elective classes are offered on student choice by selecting at least 6 elective choices. Health Grade 6 is a REQUIRED course so MUST be chosen as a "P", this has been done for you.

Selecting courses on the course card does NOT guarantee placement into the elective choice. They are only requests.

Make your choices wisely. We CANNOT honor schedule changes once the school year begins.

Other Scheduling Notes

INTENSIVE READING:

If your child receives a Level 1 on the FAST state Reading test in May they will need to be placed into an Intensive Reading course as an intervention to provide additional support. This course will be in addition to their grade level Language Arts class. In order to have this class on their schedule, it will take the place of an elective course. Intensive Reading is a year long course.

COURSE RECOVERY:

If a student does not successfully maintain a passing semester grade in their current grade level for their core content classes (ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies), they will automatically be removed from their elective choices and placed in the Learning Lab to complete course recovery.

Year Long courses

CHOICE COURSES:

Fine Arts:

- Band 1*
- Chorus 1*

Instrumental Techniques 1* (Percussion)

*May require additional fees. Classes are co-curricular and require mandatory out of school, evening attendance for performances that are part the student's grade.

World Languages:

H/S Spanish I

*Students must earn a level 3 or higher on ELA PM 3 FAST. Those who do choose Spanish and do not score a 3 will be placed in a year long middle school Spanish course and will transition to the high school course the following year.

PE

Opt- Out

All students are required to take a physical education course per state statute each school year, unless the parent/guardian makes the choice to waive them out.

PE Waiver Statement:

Senate Bill 610 requires the equivalent of one class period per day of physical education for one semester each year for students in grades 6-8. The physical education requirement shall be waived for a student who meets one of the following criteria: a) The student is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course, b) the parent requests the student enroll in another course from among those offered as options by the school district, or c) the student is participating in physical activities outside the school day, which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement.

Health On-line Request

If your student will take the required Health course online through Pasco eSchool this summer, please use the QR code to submit your request.

- Registration instructions will be sent after Spring Break.
- The course must be completed by the summer eSchool deadline (usually mid-July).
- If the course is not finished by that deadline, your student will need to take Health in person next school year.
- If you plan for your student to take the course online but they are not registered, logged in, and started the class before school ends in May, they will be scheduled for the in-person Health class next semester.
