#### **POSITION DESCRIPTIONS**

### PRESIDENT (EXECUTIVE BOARD) - 7th Grade only

Leads the whole student government with the sponsor, assists the sponsor with managing events, communicates with all members, assists with leading meetings.

### VICE PRESIDENT (EXECUTIVE BOARD) - 6th or 7th Grade

Assists the president and sponsor with running student government, assists with managing events, communicates with all members, assists with leading meetings.

## SECRETARY (EXECUTIVE BOARD) - 6th or 7th grade

In charge of recording minutes and taking notes during meetings. This position will take attendance and review prior meeting notes at the beginning of each meeting.

### COMMITTEE MANAGER - 6th or 7th grade

Responsible for placing members on committees, delegating tasks to the different committees, and ensuring committees are completing tasks assigned.

### SPIRIT MANAGER - 6th or 7th grade

In charge of leading student government in planning pep rallies, spirit weeks, and other school spirit events. Communicates with adminstration in charge of events.

## PUBLICITY MANAGER - 6th or 7th grade

In charge of promotion of student government events: ex: directing the making of flyers or posters, writing social media posts, writing communications for school news.

## CLASS REPRESENTATIVES 6TH GRADE (HOUSES)

There will be a representative from each house. Class representatives are the voice for all 6<sup>th</sup> graders by asking for their input and sharing their views. Assist with events, projects, and ideas for the whole student government and 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

### CLASS REPRESENTATIVES 7TH GRADE (HOUSES)

There will be a representative from each house. Class representatives are the voice for all 7<sup>th</sup> graders by asking for their input and sharing their views. Assist with events, projects, and ideas for the whole student government and 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
